P-EBT: Have You Heard?



"Expungement"

If you get a letter from OKDHS titled "SNAP Expungement Notice," it means your P-EBT benefits will expire if you do not use them soon. See your letter for deadline details.

What to do next:

- If you have a P-EBT card but haven't activated it, call 888-328-6551 (toll-free) to activate. Use it at least once before the deadline in your letter.
- If you lost or threw your card away, call the toll-free number with your child's STN* to request a new card. When received, activate and use the card before your letter's deadline.
- If you misplaced your card and need to update your address to get a replacement, call OKDHS at (405)-522-5050 with your child's **STN*** to update your information and then call the toll-free number to request a new card.
- Make a purchase by the deadline in your letter and use your P-EBT card at least once every 273 days to keep from losing benefits.
- Hold on to your card in case more benefits come later.

*STN – 10-digit state testing number, used in place of your child's Social Security Number on your P-EBT card account. If you don't know your child's STN, please contact your school.



Where can P-EBT cards be used?





- Use your P-EBT card at least once every 273 days to keep from losing benefits. See back for details.
